The Policy Board of the Sherman-Denison Metropolitan Planning Organization (SDMPO) amended the Bylaws of the SDMPO to expand the boundaries of its Metropolitan Planning Area on August 3, 2016. The Bylaws state that the Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) shall be defined as covering the area delineated by the Grayson County boundaries.

In order to make the revised boundaries official, TxDOT requires approval of a resolution by the Commissioners Court requesting membership into the Sherman-Denison Metropolitan Planning Organization.
